

This is confirmed in our Asian intercountry network for different sectors



#### **Our inter-country networking indicates four common features**

(1) Build on local good practice

(2) Focus on <u>low-cost improvements</u> in multiple areas

(3) Use a <u>locally adjusted toolkit</u> for direct use of local people

(4) Network trained facilitators






